As a result of NPU's GE program, a student will be able to:

1. Demonstrate knowledge in, make connections among and demonstrate critical thinking and problem solving skills in a variety of subject areas outside of one's major field of study.
2. Demonstrate information literacy and proficiency with and an appreciation of technology as it applies to society and demonstrate an understanding of the appropriate and ethical uses of technology.
3. Demonstrate a knowledge of at least one non-Western culture and an appreciation for the ethical obligations global citizenship entails.
4. Demonstrate an ability to be reflective and self-critical.
5. Communicate effectively in a variety of media: written, oral, and visual.
6. Express a vision for one's life's course and purpose.
7. Demonstrate an ability to work with others and appreciate differences.
8. Demonstrate a knowledge of and appreciation for the biblical message, Jesus of Nazareth, and a Christian perspective on God, self, and the world.
9. Demonstrate knowledge and appreciation of multiple cultures other than one's own.
